Application Materials needed for consignment:

CAM-PLEX; Central Pavilion

1. Completed & signed consignment form

- Gillette, Wyoming
- 2. Copy of registration papers (or will be sold as GRADE). DO NOT mail original papers with this application.
- 3. Catalog fee of \$300 per horse. This fee is non-refundable.
- 4. High quality photo in electronic format emailed to cowboycountryhorses@gmail.com

Once selected for the sale:

- 1. Original registration papers and signed transfer must be received in CCHS office by March, 1st.
- 2. If horse isn't selected, catalog fee will be refunded.

Commission: 8% or minimum of \$250

No-Sale Policy: Consignors will be charged a flat fee of \$300 per head. No-sale fee MUST be paid prior to owner receiving paperwork back and horse exiting the facility. ABSOLUTELY NO alley trading will be allowed. All transactions MUST go through the CCHS Office.

Withdrawal Policy: All horses consigned to the sale MUST enter the sale ring. A \$400 withdrawal fee will be assessed on consignments pulled from the sale without a vet release.

Guarantee: Accountability of guaranteeing the sound and healthy condition of the consigned horse(s) fall on each individual consignor. Additional guarantees made by individual consignors for their horse(s) are acceptable and encouraged. You must stand by your guarantee. Neither Cowboy Country Horse Sale or St. Onge Livestock act as agent or representative for buyer or seller, but merely provides an environment for binding together buyer and seller for the purpose of sale transactions. If an adjustment needs to be made, it must be between the purchaser and the consignor.

Submitting Photos: Photos are required. Please email high quality photos to cowboycountryhorse@gmail.com. Full color photos are used at the discretion of the horse sale committee, but aren't guaranteed to be printed in the catalog. CCHS will not be held liable for any copyright infringement. In order to advertise your horse to the best of our ability, it is imperative to have HIGH QUALITY photos, both profile view and action shots if available. The most desirable profile shot is a side shot with the mane facing the camera. If photos don't meet the standards of the CCHS sale committee you will be asked for new ones.

Submitting Videos: Sale videos are encouraged. Please be sure to take all of the videos and combine them into ONE video using software such as iMovie or KineMaster. Upload the video to YouTube and email the link to cowboycountryhorses@gmail.com.

Needed at time of check-in:

- In-State Horses-
 - Coggins 10 months old or less
 - Brand inspection ONLY if crossing county lines
 - Vet affidavit of age if selling as grade.
 - o Breeding soundness exam from veterinarian if selling breeding aged stallion.
- Out-Of-State Horses-
 - Coggins 10 months old or less
 - Brand inspection
 - Current Health Certificate
 - Vet affidavit of age if selling as grade.
 - Breeding soundness exam from veterinarian if selling breeding aged stallion.

Important Information:

- We cannot guarantee there will be timely updates on your pictures or videos up to two weeks before the sale.
- Timely submission of your consignment ensures fewer errors. Once catalogs go to print, we can no longer make any edits.
- The name on the brand is who we are legally obligated to write the check to, please plan accordingly.
- CCHS Sale Committee decisions are final. CCHS Sale Committee reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with the or incident to the sale.
