

**Consignment Deadline:  
February 19th at 11:59PM Mountain Time**

## **Application Materials needed for consignment:**

- 1. Consignment form completed**
- 2. Copy of registration papers (or will be sold as GRADE). DO NOT mail original papers with application.**
- 3. Catalog fee of \$300 per horse. This fee is non-refundable.**
- 4. High quality photo in electronic format**

## **Once Selected for Sale:**

- Original registration papers and signed transfer must be recieved by March, 1st.**
- If horse isn't selected, catalog fee will be refunded.**

## **Fees:**

- \$300 Catalog Fee: Non-refundable**
- \$300 No Sale Fee: The "no sale" fee must be paid prior to the horse exiting the sale facility and any registration papers being given back to the consignor**
- 8% commission or a minimum of \$250.**

## **Needed at time of check-in:**

- Hard copy of Health Certificate**
- Hard copy of Negative Coggins Test**
- Brand Inspection Papers**



- 1. CCHS Committee decisions are final.**
- 2. Check-in time starts at 8 AM Saturday, March 16th, 2024. Horses consigned must report to check -in located at Barn 3 of CAM-PLEX.**
- 3. At the time of check-in all sale horses must present the following:**
  - a. Hard copy of Health Certificate, negative Coggins Test, & Brand Inspection Papers**
- 4. Stalls are available for sale horses at CAM-PLEX.**
- 5. No sales will be charged a flat fee of \$300.**
- 6. The consignors meeting is at 9 AM Saturday, March 16th.**
- 7. The sale will be held at CAM-PLEX Central Pavilion. Consignor must furnish feed, water and care for horses until the horse(s) are sold. Please make arrangement with buyer for care and transportation of the horse after the sale.**
- 8. All horses consigned to the sale must enter the sale ring. If the animal doesn't enter the sale ring, a withdrawal fee of \$400 will automatically be assessed.**
- 9. The CCHS committee, CAM-PLEX, & the Campbell County Public Landboard, or their employees will not be responsible for any injury to or loss of any animal or accidents there by or any injury or loss of life to any participants or spectators during the CCHS weekend events.**
- 10. The CCHS committee reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with or incident to the Sale.**
- 11. Each consignor accepts the responsibility of guaranteeing their own horse(s) at the time of their sale in the Sale Ring.**
- 12. The CCHS committee does not act as agent for or represent either the buyer or the seller but merely provides an environment for binding together buyer and seller for the purpose of sale transactions. If an adjustment needs to be made, it must be between the purchaser and the consignor.**
- 13. All consignors will be held to the General Rules and Requirements of consignment whether or not you read and/or sign the contract.**
